Salary

School fee remission

A staff fee remission is provided for staff children at St Margaret's. Places for staff children are subject to space availability and the normal entry assessments.

Pension

Teaching staff are able to join the Teachers' Pension Scheme. Pension contribution rates are variable, currently between 7.4% per annum and 11.7% per annum, dependent on salary (employee), and 16.48% (employer).

Training

St Margaret's is committed to the continuing professional development of staff and will support further inservice training as required. There are generous INSET and Continuing Professional Development (CPD) budgets.

Meals

Staff are provided with a complimentary lunch and break time refreshments during term time.

Sports Membership

Staff are entitled to free membership of the School Sports Centre. This includes use of our 25-metre indoor swimming pool, floodlit tennis/netball courts & fitness suite, comprising of large range of cardiovascular equipment and free weights.
